

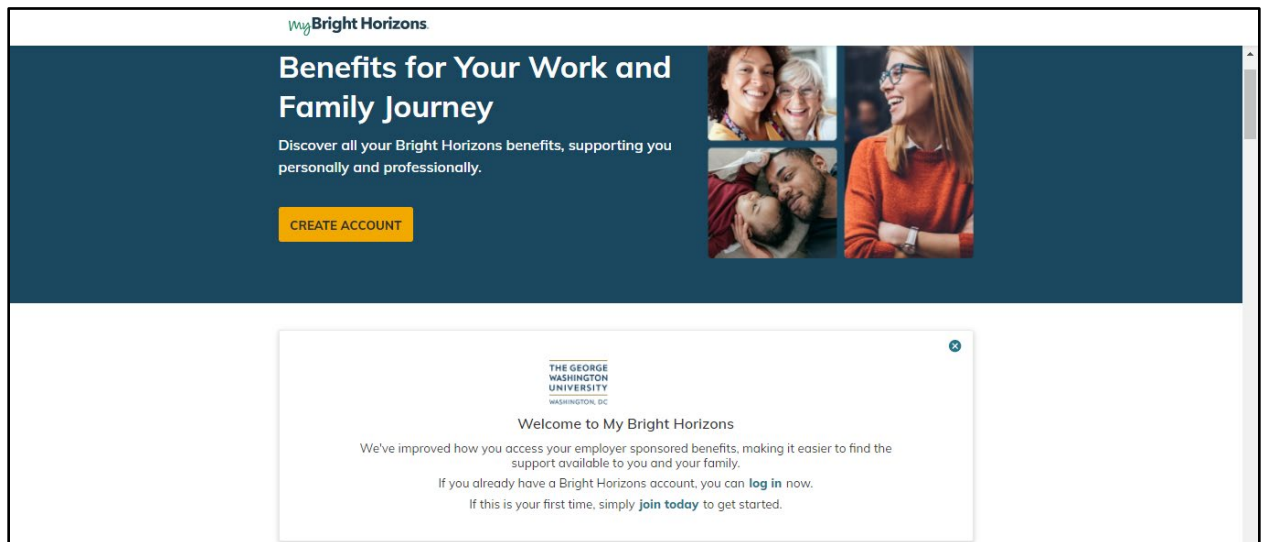
Registration Instructions for Enhanced Family Support from Bright Horizons

GW is excited to introduce [***Bright Horizons Enhanced Family Supports™***](#) for benefits-eligible employees and their dependents. The program includes:


- Expanded in-center back-up care at both Bright Horizons and KinderCare centers.

2. Next, create a unique username and password.
